

MOTION NO. 5135

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$8,224 to support Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Program, Grant File No. 056:2.

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Justice and the Delinquency Planning Act of 1974, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Program will assist the County and coordinate Juvenile Justice activities, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$8,224 as an in kind match in support of the project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$8,224 to the Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, through the State Division of Criminal Justice on behalf of King County,

PROVIDED THAT, the application is amended to state the intent of the King County Council that the proposed Coordinating Council be terminated one year from the date it is established, unless it is specifically reauthorized by the County Council;

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, any plans or listing of priorities recommended by the Coordinating Council be approved by the King County Council prior to their submission to the State of Washington.

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file

1 and execute such grant application and to enter into and execute  
 2 a contract with the Washington State Office of Financial  
 3 Management, Division of Criminal Justice, to carry out County  
 4 responsibilities as defined in the application.


5 3. The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into  
 6 and execute a personal services contract in an amount not to  
 7 exceed \$7,700 for the purpose of analyzing juvenile issues  
 8 throughout King County and preparing Requests for Proposals  
 9 based upon State priorities.

10 4. The Department of Justice and State of Washington are  
 11 hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights  
 12 Act.


13 5. It is the Council's intent that County Departments and  
 14 Divisions shall not apply for moneys provided for direct services.
