4 A MOTION declaring the week of May 9 through  
5 May 17 as 1981 King County Bicycle Week.

6 WHEREAS, leaders and members of King County and Puget Sound  
7 Bicycle Clubs have, through a concerted effort, planned  
8 activities over a nine-day period that will be educational,  
9 interesting, valuable, and enjoyable for their memberships and  
10 anyone who is a bicycle enthusiast, and

11 WHEREAS, a "TOWN HALL MEETING" has been scheduled in our  
12 Council Chambers at 7:30 p.m., Wednesday, May 13, 1981 with the  
13 Chairman of the Washington State Transportation Committee and  
14 other legislators to explain to them the statewide concerns of  
15 bicyclists, and

16 WHEREAS, the King County Council has demonstrated its  
17 intent to provide for the bicycling public by the adoption of  
18 the Urban Trails Plan of 1971, the General Bicycle Plan in  
19 1976, and, as a means of energy conservation policy, made  
20 additions to the County's Comprehensive Plan in 1978, and

21 WHEREAS, the Council is aware that bicycling, as a viable  
22 and legitimate means of transportation, fun, recreation,  
23 physical fitness, and as an individual sport or family  
24 activity, is an important means of saving energy, fuel, and  
25 money, and

26 WHEREAS, the King County Council intends continued support  
27 of the bicycling community within the limits of present reduced  
28 revenues and increased costs, and

29 WHEREAS, planned activities of 1981 Bicycle Week indicate  
30 that they will be extensive and varied, as shown by the  
31 attachment entitled, "Puget Sound Bicycle Week," and

32 WHEREAS, organizers and workers who have made this Eighth  
33 Annual King County Bicycle Week a reality, and who, through

1 their efforts have greatly improved the quality of life for  
2 people in King County, are hereby commended by the King County  
3 Council.

4 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

5 The period of time from May 9 through May 17, 1981 is  
6 hereby declared King County Bicycle Week.
