WHEREAS, Snohomish County has the asphalt plant, equipment and personnel to level and surface the 1.7 miles of roads, and



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The King County Council authorizes the County Executive to enter into an agreement with Snohomish County, the funds budgeted in the 1981 North County Special Maintenance.
