A MOTION commending Target Seattle for providing a public forum for discussing alternatives for preventing nuclear war.

WHEREAS, "Target Seattle: Preventing Nuclear War" will be held in the Seattle Metropolitan area, September 24 through October 2, 1982, and

WHEREAS, it is a symposium sponsored by a broad-based, non-partisan coalition and is meant to accomodate people of differing ideas and viewpoints, and

WHEREAS, it is based on the premise "that no rational person or nation wants nuclear war but that reasonable people differ on how best to avert it", and

WHEREAS, it focuses public attention on this extremely important and timely issue and affords citizens an opportunity to systematically consider the principle strategies now being advanced to avert a nuclear catastrophe;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council commends Target Seattle, its Advisory Committee and its Executive Committee for focusing public attention on the vital issue of preventing nuclear war and for provding this forum for public discussion.
