MOTION NO. 7508

A MOTION concurring with the King County Executive's allocation of \$9,600 in Community Development Block Grant funds for the Virginia V Foundation

WHEREAS, the county council has, through Ordinance 2991 and Ordinance 4828, adopted the goal of preserving and selectively encouraging the restoration of buildings, sites and areas that depict the evolution of King County, and

WHEREAS, the county council has, through Ordinance 8331 authorized the expenditure of 1988 Community Development Block Grant funds for historic preservation projects, and

WHEREAS, the landmarks commission has reviewed project proposals based on published criteria and has named the Virginia V for 1988 CDBG assistance, and

WHEREAS, the county council has recommended that Virginia V Foundation adopt specific programs to benefit special populations, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has reviewed and concurred with these recommendations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County council concurs with the county executive's allocation of historic preservation CDBG funds in the amount of \$9,600 for the Virginia V restoration project,




