MOTION NO. 7533

A MOTION adopting the program plan for the King County Reading Program including the Summer Day Camp Reading Program established in the 1989 budget.

WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes the importance of providing children with strong reading skills so that they may take their place as productive members of their community, and

WHEREAS, there are large numbers of children in the county who need special assistance in the skills of reading, reading comprehension, and self-expression through the written word, and

WHEREAS, the county council strongly supports programs of the highest possible benefit to youth, including the benefit of encouraging higher education, and

WHEREAS, the county summer work training program, through the Seattle-King County Private Industry Council, provides summer job opportunities and work experience for economically disadvantaged youth, and

WHEREAS, there are numerous high school students of high scholastic ability who hope to attend college but need to earn money to pay their own way, and

WHEREAS, the 1989 adopted budget includes an appropriation of \$148,000 for the King County Reading Program, and

WHEREAS, the 1988 Summer Day Camp Reading Program provided valuable reading enhancement activities to more than 80 young children who were at risk of being non-readers, and

WHEREAS, the 1988 Summer Day Camp Reading Program offered excellent training and work experience to 40 disadvantaged teenagers enrolled in the summer work training program;

1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

2 The attached program plan for the King County Reading
3 Program including the proposed sites, the role of the Boys' and
4 Girls' Clubs of King County, the role of Washington Literacy,
5 the responsibilities of the work training program,
6 implementation timeline, and the budget for the Summer Day Camp
7 Reading Program, are hereby adopted.

8 BE IT FURTHER MOVED,


9 The Executive is directed to maintain the Summer Day Camp
