MOTION NO. **7581**

A MOTION authorizing the Executive to enter into negotiations with the City of Seattle for the funding of marine patrol services with proceeds from the local County option boat tax, and authorizing the county executive to enter into such an Interlocal Agreement effective January 1 through December 31, 1989.

WHEREAS, King County has traditionally been willing to assist cities within its jurisdiction when called upon to do so, and

WHEREAS, King County as since 1985 maintained an interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle for the purpose of levying a local option Boat Tax for the support of marine patrol services, and

WHEREAS, the present interlocal agreement lapsed on December 31, 1988, and


WHEREAS, King County is required to contract with municipalities providing marine patrol services by interlocal agreement, and is required to provide compensation to those municipalities in accordance with RCW Chapter 82.49.070;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The county executive is authorized to negotiate and execute an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Seattle for the purpose of levying a local option Boat Tax and sharing the proceeds to provide marine patrol operations to the City of Seattle corporate limits from January 1 through December 31, 1989.
