

MOTION NO. 7594

A MOTION confirming Executive appointments to the Commission for Marketing Recyclable Materials.

WHEREAS, the King County Council approved Ordinance 9024, establishing a 21-member Commission for Marketing Recyclable Materials;

WHEREAS, the Commission will establish, enhance and assure utilization of methods for reusing materials which would otherwise be disposed and will recommend policy to King County and other County jurisdictions to enhance the development of markets for use of recycled and recyclable materials;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. There shall be a Commission composed of members representing the solid waste collection companies certified by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the recycling industry, manufacturers located in King County, chambers of commerce, trade and economic development councils, the City of Seattle, the Port of Seattle, institutions of higher education located in King County, citizen groups with an interest in recycling, at least one King County Councilmember, and at least one representative appointed by the President of the Suburban Cities Association. The following persons are appointed to the Commission for Marketing Recyclable Materials:



B. Terms. Appointments to the Commission shall be for three-year terms beginning on July 1 of the year in which the term starts and initial terms will be established by lot.


1 C. Annual Report. The Commission shall prepare annually,
2 for publication in July of each year and transmittal to the
3 executive, county and public, a report of its budget, activities
4 for the preceding calendar year and goals, policy recommendations
5 and financial plans for the following five year period; except
6 that the first report of the Commission shall be submitted by
7 November 1, 1989, and shall include a proposed 1990 budget and
8 work plan.
