A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application in the approximate amount of \$3,500 to support a long range strategic planning process to address present and future problems within the Juvenile Court system.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee is empowered to make grants to support the juvenile justice system, and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court Judges Committee requires the services of a consultant to assist in the long range strategic planning process to address problems within the Juvenile Court System, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds the provision of funds for a consultant is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$3,500 to Governor's Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee, for the provision of a consultant for the long range strategic planning process to address problems within the Juvenile Court system;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

D. The Governor's Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
