A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$500,000 to support a Lake Sammamish Water Quality Project, Grant File No. 209.

WHEREAS, Lake Sammamish is a regionally significant body of water, and

WHEREAS, the area surrounding Lake Sammamish is experiencing accelerated development which, without protection, may result in decreased water quality of the lake, and

WHEREAS, the Lake Sammamish Water Quality Management Report recommends structural and nonstructural controls to minimize phosphorus loading to Lake Sammamish in the future, and

WHEREAS, an interlocal agreement is authorized by Motion 8239, with the cities of Bellevue, Issaquah and Redmond, and with Metro, to implement the recommendations, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology has funds available for preventive actions to minimize phosphorous loading to Lake Sammamish;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$500,000 to the Department of Ecology for Referendum 39 funds to support a Lake Sammamish Water Quality Project on behalf of King County;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;


C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;


D. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
