

ORDINANCE NO. 00327

AN ORDINANCE granting subpoena power to the King County Personnel Board.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Article V, Section 540 of the King County Charter, the King County Personnel Board is hereby granted the power to issue subpoenas and subpoenas duces tecum to compel the attendance of witnesses before the Board and to provide information relevant to any appeal within the jurisdiction of the Board: provided, that any witness shall have the right to be represented by counsel.
