3 WHEREAS, a hearing on the proposed Assessment Roll of King  
4 County Road Improvement District No. 53 having been held on  
5 October 19, 1970, in accordance with Motion No. 320, after  
6 proper notice, and with no protests having been approved, now,  
7 therefore,

8 BE IT ORDAINED that the Construction Assessment Roll of  
9 County Road Improvement District No. 53, as prepared by the  
10 Director of the Department of Public Works, and now on file with  
11 the King County Council be and the same is hereby accepted and  
12 confirmed, and

13 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said Assessment Roll be filed  
14 with the Treasurer of King County, Washington, for collection  
15 and that said Treasurer public notice as required by law, after  
16 said roll is in his hands for collection, and that any assess-  
17 ments thereon, or any portion of said assessments may be paid at  
18 any time within thirty (30) days from the date of the first  
19 publication of said notice without penalty, interest, or cost,  
20 and

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the assessments for construction  
22 against the property in King County Road Improvement District  
23 No. 53 be payable in ten (10) equal annual installments; that  
24 said assessments and unpaid installments thereof shall bear  
25 interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, payable  
26 annually at the time of the payment of the annual installments,  
27 and

28 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all assessments and any  
29 installments thereof, together with interest thereon, when  
30 delinquent shall bear a penalty of five per cent (5%), and the  
31 interest and penalty shall be included and shall be a part of  
32 the assessment lien, and

33 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that such assessments and installments

thereof be due and payable as follows:

"The first installment of the assessment for construction shall become due and payable during the thirty (30) day period succeeding the date one year after the date of the first publication of such notice, and annually thereafter each succeeding installment shall become due and payable in a like manner. If the whole or any portion of any assessment remains unpaid after the thirty (30) day period following the date of the first publication of said notice, interest upon the whole unpaid sum shall be charged at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, and each year thereafter one of said installments, together with interest due upon the whole of the unpaid balance, shall be collected. Any installments not paid prior to the expiration of the thirty (30) day period, during which such installment is due and payable, shall there upon become delinquent.

All delinquent installments shall, until paid, be subject to the charge for interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum and to an additional charge of five per cent (5%) penalty levied upon both principal and interest due upon such installment or installments from the date of delinquency. Collection on such delinquent installments shall be enforced in the manner provided by law, and any unpaid balance, plus interest, may be paid in full at any time."


