ORDINANCE NO. 743

AN ORDINANCE finding additional revenue for 1971 and granting supplemental appropriations to the Department of Public Safety for the operation of the Alcohol Safety Action Program (ASAP) project, and amending Ordinance No. 639.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. The Council hereby acknowledges that grant funds in the amount of \$191,587 for the Department of Public Safety's Alcohol Safety Action Program (ASAP) project have been received from the U. S. Department of Transportation through the Washington State Department of Motor Vehicles and Washington Traffic Safety Commission.

Section 2. The amount specified in Section 1 above is hereby appropriated for the 1971 fiscal year to the Department of Public Safety, provided that said appropriation may be used only for salaries and wages, employee benefits and other costs as authorized under the terms of contracts executed for the ASAP project.

Section 3. All funds appropriated in 1971 and are unexpended as of January 1, 1972, are hereby authorized to be carried forward to 1972 and appropriated to the Department of Public Safety under the appropriated project category.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 639, Section 2, concerning the Current Expense appropriation to the Department of Public Safety is hereby amended pursuant to Section 2 above.
