

ORDINANCE NO. 873

AN ORDINANCE providing for appropriation transfers from the Department of Records and Elections to the Department of Judicial Administration and to the Bureau of General Services; amending Ordinance No. 639 and establishing the effective date of said transfers.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation transfer in the amount of \$31,672 from the Department of Records and Elections to the Department of Judicial Administration, provided, that said amount shall be available to the Department of Judicial Administration for salaries and wages and associated employee benefits for six positions concurrently transferred from the Department of Records and Elections to the Department of Judicial Administration.

Section 2. There is further approved and adopted an appropriation transfer in the amount of \$15,836 from the Department of Records and Elections to the Bureau of General Services, provided, that said amount shall be available to the Bureau of General Services for salaries and wages and associated employee benefits for three positions concurrently transferred from the Department of Records and Elections to the Bureau of General Services.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 639, Section 2, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 764, 766 and 793, is hereby amended, in part, as follows:
