

ORDINANCE

NO. 1214

AN ORDINANCE acknowledging unanticipated revenues in the amount of \$4,602,707 from the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services for an expansion of Community Mental Health Programs, (County Project No. 72-M-235 appropriating said revenue to the Mental Health-Mental Retardation fund, amending Ordinance No. 1056 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The County Council acknowledges that unanticipated revenue will be received from the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services through the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Title 16, in the amount of \$4,602,797 for an expansion of the County's mental health programs.

SECTION 2: The County Council acknowledges that King County's participation under Title 16 of \$99,656 in funds presently budgeted.

SECTION 3: A supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$4,602,797 as specified in Section 1, to the Mental Health-Mental Retardation is hereby appropriated; provided that said appropriation be utilized solely for allowable expenses as specified in the agreement between King County and the granting agency as specified in Section 1.

SECTION 4: Ordinance 1056 as amended by Ordinance No. 1107 is hereby amended as follows:

Mental Health & Retardation ((\$2,688,727)) \$7,291,524

SECTION 5: The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as are required by the granting agency as specified in Section 1.
