

ORDINANCE NO. 1441

1 AN ORDINANCE reappropriating the unexpended  
2 balance of \$98,382 in the Bureau of Youth Affairs,  
3 Out-of-School Program, by the Neighborhood Youth  
4 Corps, Contract No. R-2003-53, a grant from the  
5 U.S. Department of Labor, (County Project 1-E-004)  
6 to the same program in the General Grant Fund and  
7 amending Ordinance No. 1056 as amended, and declaring  
8 an emergency.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. The County Council finds, as a fact, that  
11 \$98,382 is available from the unexpended balance of the Out-  
12 of-School Program of the Neighborhood Youth Corps operations  
13 in 1971, a U.S. Department of Labor grant No. R-2003-53, (County  
14 Project 1-E-004) for the financing of the same program in 1972.

15 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1056, General Grant Fund, as  
16 amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 Bureau of Youth Affairs - ((~~\$17,780,696~~)) \$1,879,078

18 SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares  
19 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary  
20 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety  
21 or for the support of county government and its existing public  
22 institutions.
