

1 (3) BUILDING DIVISION. The Building Division shall be responsible
2 for the administration of the County building and housing codes, including
3 issuance of permits and enforcement, and shall administer other codes and
4 regulations assigned to it.

5 (4) ARCHITECTURE DIVISION. The Architecture Division shall be
6 responsible for the administration of the King County Design Commission, shall
7 administer all projects within the purview of the Design Commission, and shall
8 administer all other projects assigned to it.

9 (5) YOUTH AFFAIRS DIVISION. The Youth Affairs Division shall be
10 responsible for the administration of County youth programs, including
11 administration of programs funded by federal and state agencies.

12 (6) HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIVISION. The Housing and
13 Community Development Division shall be responsible for the planning and
14 development of the County's programs in housing and community development,
15 including the administration of the County's responsibilities under the
16 Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.

17 SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3, Subsection (d) and KCC 2.16.070
18 are each hereby repealed.

19 NEW SECTION SECTION 4. DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT.

20 The Department of Budget and Program Development shall be responsible
21 for the administration of the Divisions of Budget and Program Development.

22 (1) BUDGET DIVISION. In accordance with Article 4 of the Charter,
23 the Budget Division shall prepare annual operating and capital improvement
24 budgets and in conjunction with the Planning and Land Use Management Division
25 prepare six-year capital improvement programs for all elements of County
26 government. The Division shall administer controls of annual budgets adopted
27 by the Council.

28 (2) PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT DIVISION. The Program Development Division
29 shall coordinate federal and state grants in aid, coordinate and maintain
30 reports required by law, evaluate new programs and provide specialized research
31 and analysis of issues of concern to King County, and coordinate such
32 intergovernmental and interdepartmental programs as may be assigned by the
33 County Executive and which are not specifically assigned by Charter or ordinance.

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1 NEW SECTION SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1,
2 1976, except that Section 2, Subsection (b) (6), in order to provide for an
3 orderly transfer of functions, shall take effect on or before April 1, 1976,
4 as is designated by the County Executive by Executive Order.
