ORDINANCE NO. 3338

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Ferrell-Weyerhaeuser to King County Water District No. 105.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Ferrell-Weyerhaeuser to King County Water District No. 105 was filed with the County Council effective October 16, 1976.

2. King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 436 and 437, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance dated August 29, 1976, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 18th day of April, 1977, to consider the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Farrell-Weyerhaeuser and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Farrell-Weyerhaeuser to be annexed is described as follows:

The area proposed for annexation consists of the following described property all in King County, Washington.

That portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 21 N, Range 6 EWM lying easterly of the plat of Lake Morton Tracts as recorded in volume 48, page 90 of Plats Records of King County, Washington;

Together with that portion of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, TWP 21 N, Range 6 EWM, lying easterly of said Lake Morton Tracts except the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8;

Together with Section 5, Township 21 N, Range 6 EWM, except Govt. Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4;

Together with the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 21 N, Range 6 EWM;
