ORDINANCE NO. **12419**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the conveyance of county road rights of way in the vicinity of SR 2, Forest Boundary - West, located in council district 3, to the State of Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

King County is the record owner of county roads rights of way together with all appurtenance thereto, located within the highway project limits of SR 2, Forest Boundary - West, all located in council district 3.

The improvement of SR 2 by the Washington State Department of Transportation makes it necessary and advisable for the State to acquire title to county road rights of way for said highway project.

Upon completion of the project, the State will quit claim deed rights of way along the project area back to King County.

R.C.W. 47.12.040 authorizes the State of Washington to acquire title to county road rights of way that lie within State highway projects by quit claim deed for a consideration of mutual benefits.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to convey the county road rights of way, for mutual benefits, described as follows:

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
SR 2, Forest Boundary - West

Forest Boundary - West, in Section 26, Township 26
North, Range 12 East, W.M.
