

ORDINANCE NO **12449**

AN ORDINANCE extending sewer franchise number 5176, water franchise number 5292 and water and sewer franchise number 6828 for the City of Snoqualmie until August 1, 1998, authorizing the issuance of right-of-way construction permits in Council District 12, and declaring an emergency.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. The City of Snoqualmie's franchise numbers 5176, 5292 and 6828 to operate and maintain water and sewer systems on county roads in council district 12 have expired.
2. The City of Snoqualmie has requested extension of said franchises for two years to allow them to obtain county approval of their comprehensive plans and meanwhile to obtain permits for water and sewer projects already scheduled.
3. The City of Snoqualmie has obtained conditional approval of its water comprehensive plan from the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC); the City will be submitting an updated sewer comprehensive plan in 1997.
4. The extension of the franchises until August 1, 1998 will allow sufficient time for Snoqualmie to obtain County approval of its water and sewer comprehensive plans and new water and sewer franchises.
5. The chair of the UTRC has no objection to the extension of water franchises as Snoqualmie is updating its water comprehensive plan to conform to the conditions of approval agreed upon at the July 24, 1996 UTRC meeting. The UTRC chair supports extension of the sewer franchises provided that the extension only covers King County rights-of-way adjoining Snoqualmie's city limits and that any new facilities serve only development within the City of Snoqualmie, consistent with County-wide Planning Policy LU-38.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 6.27 to the contrary,

the King County executive is hereby authorized to grant an extension of sewer franchise number 5176, water franchise number 5292 and water and sewer franchise number 6828 for the City of Snoqualmie until August 1, 1998, in substantially the same form as Attachment "A". Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 14.44 to the contrary, the executive is also authorized to issue right of way construction permits consistent with terms of the extended franchise. Right-of-way construction permits issued by the property services division between the franchise expiration dates and the execution date of the franchise extension agreements by King County and the City of Snoqualmie shall be considered issued under the terms of the original franchises and the franchise extension agreements.

FRANCHISE EXTENSION AGREEMENT

RECITALS

WHEREAS, King County sewer franchise number 5176 issued to the City of Snoqualmie to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system in County road right-of-way has expired, and

WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie has requested a two year extension of said franchise, and

WHEREAS, the extension of the franchise until August 1, 1998 will give the City an opportunity to complete its sewer comprehensive plan and obtain County approval of its plan and sewer franchise as required by King County Code 13.24 and 6.27, and

WHEREAS, the chair of the Utilities Technical Review Committee supports the extension of this franchise provided that the extension includes only King County rights-of-way adjoining Snoqualmie's city limits and that the new facilities serve only development within the City of Snoqualmie, consistent with County-wide Planning Policy LU-38, and

WHEREAS, the legal description for sewer franchise number 5176 was limited to 384th Avenue SE, a County road which adjoins Snoqualmie's city limits, and

WHEREAS, King County has approved the extension of this franchise until August 1, 1998 through passage of Ordinance 12449.

NOW THEREFORE, King County, Washington and the City of Snoqualmie, Washington agree as follows:

1. Subject to the conditions set forth below the term of King County sewer franchise number 5176 is hereby approved and extended so that it will now expire on August 1, 1998.
2. Consistent with County-wide Planning Policy LU-38, King County sewer franchise number 5176 is amended to prohibit the construction of new mains or service connections to serve development outside the Snoqualmie city limits.
3. All other conditions of King County sewer franchise number 5176 shall remain in full force and effect and are not modified by this agreement.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the chair of the Utilities Technical Review Committee supported the granting of this extension, and

WHEREAS, King County has approved the extension of this franchise until August 1, 1998 through passage of Ordinance 12449.

NOW THEREFORE, King County, Washington and the City of Snoqualmie, Washington agree as follows:

1. The term of King County water franchise number 5292 is hereby approved and extended so that it will now expire on August 1, 1998.
2. All other conditions of King County water franchise number 5292 shall remain in full force and effect and are not modified by this agreement.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, King County water and sewer franchise number 6828 issued to the City of Snoqualmie to construct, operate and maintain a water and sewer system in County road right-of-way has expired, and

WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie has requested a two year extension of said franchise, and

WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie is currently updating its water comprehensive plan to conform to the conditions of approval agreed on at the July 24, 1996 Utilities Technical Review Committee meeting, and

WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie will update its sewer comprehensive plan in 1997 and,

WHEREAS, the extension of the franchise until August 1, 1998 will give the City an opportunity to obtain County approval of its water and sewer comprehensive plans and franchises as required by King County Code 13.24 and 6.27, and

WHEREAS, the chair of the Utilities Technical Review Committee has no objection to the extension of the water portion of the franchise, and

WHEREAS, the chair of the UTRC supports extension of the sewer portion provided that the extension for sewer includes only King County rights-of-way adjoining Snoqualmie's city limits and that the new facilities serve only development within the City of Snoqualmie, consistent with County-wide Planning Policy LU-38, and

WHEREAS, King County has approved the extension of this franchise until August 1, 1998 through passage of Ordinance 12449.

NOW THEREFORE, King County, Washington and the City of Snoqualmie, Washington agree as follows:

1. Subject to the conditions set forth below, the term of King County water and sewer franchise number 6828 is hereby approved and extended so that it will now expire on August 1, 1998.
2. Consistent with County-wide Planning Policy LU-38, King County water and sewer franchise number 6828 is amended to limit the approved legal description for sewer service to those County roads within franchise 6828's legal description which adjoin Snoqualmie's city limits (384th Avenue SE and SE North Bend Way).
3. Consistent with County-wide Planning Policy LU-38, King County water and sewer franchise number 6828 is amended to prohibit the construction of new sewer mains or service connections to serve development outside the Snoqualmie city limits.
4. All other conditions of King County water and sewer franchise number 6828 shall remain in full force and effect and are not modified by this agreement.
