RESOLUTION BY THE [REDACTED] OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, King County is the record owner of certain roads and/or streets within the limits of the right of way for Primary State Highway No. 1 (SR 5), Seattle Freeway, East 145th Street to East 200th Street, and

WHEREAS, in the improvement of Primary State Highway No. 1 (SR 5) Seattle Freeway, East 145th Street to East 200th Street, by the State of Washington, Department of Highways, it is necessary and advisable for the State of Washington to acquire title to said roads and/or streets for right of way for said highways; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration by the KING COUNTY COUNCIL [REDACTED] of King County, it appears to the said board that it will be of the best interests of both King County and the State of Washington that King County convey said roads and/or streets to the State of Washington by quit claim deed for a consideration of Mutual Benefits.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the KING COUNTY COUNCIL [REDACTED] of King County, Washington that King County, in accordance with R.C.W. 47.12.040 and through its KING COUNTY COUNCIL [REDACTED] to deliver said deed to the State of Washington, Department of Highways.
