WHEREAS, Resolution No. 6735 passed by the Board of County Commissioners on January 17, 1937, sets up certain requirements for the improvement of streets in platted areas, and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 1969 a plat was filed known as FAIRWOOD PARK DIVISION NO. 14 in Section 22 Township 23 North Range 5 East W.M. recorded in Volume 83 of Plats, pages 81 and 82, Records of KinggGounty, in which a number of streets were to be improved under the platting laws of King Gounty, and

WHEREAS, a performance bond in the sum of \$10,000 with Travelers Indemnity Company was filed to guarantee the construction of streets, and

WHEREAS, the necessary street improvements have been completed in compliance with the platting laws of King County and the State of Washington now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the streets in the plat of FAIRWOOD PARK DIVISION NO. 14 be accepted by King County and the bond of \$10,000 with Travelers Indemnity Company to guarantee this work be and is hereby meleased, provided that this resolution accepting the above streets in no way establishes permanent grade thereon.
