WHEREAS, Chapter 186, Laws of 1937, grants the County Commissioners authority to set up rules and regulations governing the platting, subdivision and dedication of land, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 6735 passed by the Board of County Commissioners on January 17, 1937, sets up certain requirements for the improvement of streets in platted areas, and

WHEREAS, on December 22, 1959, a plat was filed known as WAVERLY HILLS in Section 8, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M., recorded in Volume 63 of Plats, page 68, records of King County, in which a number of streets were to be improved under the platting laws of King County, and

WHEREAS, a performance bond in the sum of \$9,000 with Massachusetts Bonding and Insurance Company was filed to guarantee the construction of streets, and

WHEREAS, the necessary street improvements have been completed in compliance with the platting laws of King County and the State of Washington, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the streets in the plat of WAVERLY HILLS be accepted by King County and the bond of \$9,000.00 with Massachusetts Bonding and Insurance Company to guarantee this work be and is hereby released, provided that this resolution accepting the above streets in no way establishes permanent grade thereon.
