THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

A NECESSITY: 28th Ave. So. (S. 204th St. - So. 192nd St.)

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the King County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

28th Ave. So.

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline: Beginning at a point at the intersection of 28th Ave. So. & So. 204th St. said point being N.1°15'22"W 1320.23 Ft. from the SW Cor. of the SE¼ of SE¼ of Sec. 4, Twp. 22 N., R. 4 E., W.M.; thence northerly 4348.69 feet to a terminus at the intersection of 28th Ave. So. & So. 192nd St. said terminus being S.87°42'40"E 1325.45 ft. from the N.¼ Cor. of said Section 4.

4348.69 Ft. = 0.82 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity and herewith directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and to report upon same as required by law.
