THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

A NECESSITY: NE 124th St.
(SR 405 to 132nd Ave. NE)

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the King County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

NE 124th Street

be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the Centerline of NE 124th Street said point being S. 59°02'44"E a distance of 723.09 Ft., thence So. 70°57'14"E a distance of 450.74 Ft. to STA. 0+00, a point on the intersection of SR 405, thence S. 70°57'14"E a distance of 760 Ft. + from the West ¼ corner of Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., thence easterly 3301.31 Ft. to a terminus at the intersection of 132nd Pl. NE, said terminus being So. 89°59'01"W a distance of 571.38 Ft., thence along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 716.20 Ft. a distance of 166.42 Ft. from the east corner of Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M.

3301.31 Ft = .625 Mi.

The King County Council herewith finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity and herewith directs the County Engineer to make an examination of said road and to report upon same as required by law.
