

MOTION NO. 77

KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

Kerriston - Echo Lake Road

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the King County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

Kerriston-Echo Lake Road

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning on the centerline of Kerriston Road at a point N. 77° 44' 16" W a distance of 2575.61 ft. from the E. ¼ corner of Section 36, Twp. 23 N., R. 7 E. , W.M., thence in a Northerly direction a distance of 13,303.94 ft. to a terminus at STA. 134 + 00 of King County Sur. No. 36-23-7-1.

13,303.94 Ft. = 2.52 Miles

The King County Council herewith finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity and herewith directs the County Engineer to make an examination of said road and to report upon same as required by law.
