Cedar Hills Access Road

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

Cedar Hills Access Road

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at a point on the centerline of the Cedar Grove Road, said point being on the East line of Section 28, Township 23 North, Range 6 East, W.M. a distance of 1351.13 ft. southerly of the East 4 corner of said Section 28, thence in a Northerly direction a distance of 1695.00 ft. to a terminus on the centerline in the SE% of the NE% of said Section 28, said terminus being P.O.C. STA. 16+95 as surveyed by King County Road Survey No. 28-23-6-1.

1695.00 Ft. = 0.32 Mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
