

WHEREAS, on February 23, 1967, the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington passed Resolution No. 33152 which directed and authorized the County Engineer to proceed with the plans of improvement of Burns Avenue Drainage District No. 18 and take all necessary steps and measures to accomplish the purpose of said district by the construction of the improvements as set forth in the report, and

WHEREAS, the King County Engineer has now completed the construction of said improvements and determined the total cost thereof, and

WHEREAS, the King County Engineer has prepared and filed with the Clerk of the County Council a final assessment roll; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of King County, Washington as follows:

Section 1. A hearing upon the assessment roll for the improvements in Burns Avenue Drainage District No. 18 shall be held on the 5/17th day of May, 1969, at 9:30 a.m. in Room 402, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington and at such other times as the hearing may be continued.

Section 2. The County Council will sit as a Board of Equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said roll or any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made de novo as to such body shall appear just and equitable and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

Section 3. The Clerk of the County Council is hereby directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to the owner or reputed owner of the property whose name appears thereon, by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed for the hearing to such owner or reputed owner at the address of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer, in addition thereto such notices shall be published at least two (2) times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file the same with the Clerk of the Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
