

MOTION NO. 102

WHEREAS, it has been determined that King County does not have sufficient resources to effectively carry out its obligations under Chapter 84.41 RCW, to revalue real property within its boundaries for ad valorem tax purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Washington has provided the Department of Revenue with funds to aid counties in re-valuation programs, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Department of Revenue that King County shall receive a sum of approximately \$1,100,000 of said funds for the purpose of employing expert appraisers and/or supplementing the County Assessor's annual operating budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That the County Executive be authorized to enter into whatever agreements may be necessary with the Department of Revenue to obtain said State grant-in-aid funds for the purposes set forth above, and

2. That the County/be authorized to sign contracts for expert appraisal services as may be hereinafter recommended by the County Assessor, provided, however, that the total compensation for said services does not exceed the amount appropriated by the State to the County.
