MOTION NO. 107

King County Council Declaring:

144th Avenue NE (NE 190th Street northerly 1303.43 feet)

A Necessity:

Whereas, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

144th Avenue NE

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of the SE quarter of Section 3, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., said point being the point of intersection of the centerlines of NE 190th Street and 144th Avenue NE; thence northerly along the west line of said Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter for a distance of 1303.43 feet to a terminus at the Northwest corner of said Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter.

1303.43 feet = 0.25 mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
