

MOTION NO. 110

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

191st Place S.E. (S.E. 290th Street N'ly 483.26 feet)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as 191st Place S.E., be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point N 89°05'33"W a distance of 165.06 feet, thence S 0°26'04"W a distance of 483.26 feet from the NE corner of the NW¼ of the NE¼ of Section 6, Township 21 North, Range 6 East, W.M., said point being on the centerline of S.E. 290th Street, the true point of beginning, thence N'ly a distance of 483.26 feet to a terminus on the north line of said Section 6 at a point 165.06 feet N'ly of said NE corner of said subdivision.

483.26 ft. = 0.09 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
