

MOTION NO. 111

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

S.E. 128th Street (168th Avenue S.E. to 196th Avenue S.E.)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as S.E. 128th Street be established not less than 84 feet in width, nor more than 97 feet in width and having not less than 42 feet or more than 55 feet of width on either side of the following described centerline.

Beginning at a point S 87°06'22" E a distance of 1338.46 feet from the S.W. corner of Section 12, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M., thence easterly a distance of 9196.37 feet to a terminus in Section 18, Township 23 North, Range 6 East, W.M., on the centerline of 196th Avenue S.E. at P.C. Sta. 82+84.17 of King County Survey No. 18-23-6-9.

9196.37' = 1.74 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
