SECTION 3: The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to the owner or reputed owner of the propery whose name appears thereon, by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed for the hearing to such owner or reputed owner at the address of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer; in addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two (2) times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to make such objections inwriting and to file same with the Clerk of the Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
