

MOTION OF KING COUNTY COUNCIL APPROVING
THE PREPARATION OF A COMMUNITY RENEWAL
PROGRAM FOR KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON,
AND THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR A
FEDERAL GRANT TO ASSIST IN FINANCING ITS
PREPARATION.

WHEREAS under Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make grants for the preparation or completion of Community Renewal Programs; and

WHEREAS Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color or national origin under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance; and

WHEREAS it is desirable and in the public interest that King County prepare a Community Renewal Program for the unincorporated portion of the County, situated in the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS it is recognized that the federal contract for a grant to assist in the preparation of the Community Renewal Program will require, among other things, (1) preparation of the Community Renewal Program with all practicable dispatch; (2) conformance of the Community Renewal Program with the general plan of the locality as a whole; (3) provision of King County's share of the cost of preparation of the Community Renewal Program; and (4) other local obligations and responsibilities in connection with the preparation of the Community Renewal Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY
COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON,

1. That the preparation of the Community Renewal Program referred to above is hereby approved.
2. That the financial assistance under Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended, referred to above, is required to enable King County to finance the preparation of the Community Renewal Program.
3. That it is fully cognizant of the obligations and responsibilities that are imposed by a federal county act for a grant to assist in the preparation of a Community Renewal Program, and that it is the sense of this body that such obligations can and will be fulfilled.

4. That the filing of an application by King County, Washington for a grant under Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended, in an amount not to exceed \$823,150.00 to assist in financing the preparation of a Community Renewal Program for the locality is hereby authorized and approved.

5. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute and to file such application with the Department of Housing and Urban Development, to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by said Agency, to execute such contracts as are required by said Agency, and to act as the authorized correspondent of the Applicant.

6. That the United States of America and the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development is assured that King County will institute whatever necessary corrective action as might be deemed necessary as determined by the results of the Community Renewal Program.
