KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

228th Avenue SE Extension  
(East Lake Sammamish Road Easterly 6645.51 feet)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

228th Avenue SE

be established not less than 84 feet in width having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning on the East Lake Sammamish Road at a point S.13°29'45"E. a distance of 2320.63 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 16, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M; thence Easterly a distance of 6645.51 feet to a terminus at a point S.1°44'50"W., a distance of 1210.92 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section 16.

6645.51 feet = 1.26 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
