

M O T I O N N O. 128

KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

100th Avenue SE
 (SE 200th Street to SE 204th Street)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

100th Avenue SE

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the West quarter corner of Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., thence Southerly along the West line of said Section 5 a distance of 1322.38 feet to a terminus on the centerline of SE 204th Street at the Southwest corner of the NW quarter of the SW quarter of said Section 5.

1322.38 feet = 0.25 mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report same as required by law.
