MOTION NO. 136

WHEREAS, a great variety of wildlife is one of America's natural heritages and a symbol of beauty to all people, including citizens of the County of King, State of Washington; and,

WHEREAS, wildlife is also recognized as a measure of environmental quality; and,

WHEREAS, the increasing amount of pollution, industrial expansion, and other land-development projects are rapidly depleting wildlife populations and destroying the quality of man's environment; and,

WHEREAS, the period March 15-21 and the balance of 1970 will be observed throughout the Nation as a time to ask all Americans to take stock of their world with the question, "Seen any wildlife lately?"; now, therefore,

BE IT MOVED that the County of King, does hereby proclaim March 15-21 as National Wildlife Week and urges all citizens to support this vital conservation observance.
