

MOTION NO. 137

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the King County Council to establish suitable office hours to accommodate the public needs to transact business; and

WHEREAS, in providing better services hours to the public, we do not unduly inconvenience any employee until he has had a reasonable amount of time to make satisfactory adjustments in his personal schedule and method of transportation,

WE, THEREFORE, move that the County Executive, through the involved Department Heads, give due consideration during the month following the adoption of the Office Hour ordinance, to the personal needs and prior transportation arrangement problems employees may have when revising new work hour assignments.
