THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

Petrovitsky Road Extension (196th Ave. SE to SR. 18)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

Petrovitsky Road Extention

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point S 88° - 42' - 28" W. a distance of 1150.65 ft. from the E ¼ corner of Sec. 6, Twp. 22N., R. 6 E.W.M. thence SE'ly a distance of 15,940.15 ft. to a terminus at a point N 86° - 46' - 35" W. a distance of 233.33 ft. from the center of Sec. 16, Twp. 22 N., R. 6 E.W.M.

15,940.15 Ft. = 3.02 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
