be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of vacated SW 150th St. said point being the NW corner of the SW4 of the SE4 of the NE4 of Section 19, Twp. 23 N., R. 4 E., W.M., thence northerly a distance of 1338.12 ft. to a terminus on the centerline of the SW 146th Street, at a point which is the NW corner of the SW4 of the NE4 of the NE4 of Sec. 19, Twp. 23 N., R. 4 E., W.M.

1338.12 Ft. = 0.253 Miles
