THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

290th Avenue NE (NE 16th Street to NE 24th Street)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as 290th Avenue NE

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the east quarter corner of Section 30, Township 25 North, Range 7 East, W.M., thence westerly along the east-west centerline of said section on a bearing of N 89°23'22" W. for a distance of 680 feet to the true point of beginning. Thence northerly a distance of 2348.09 feet to a terminus on the centerline of NE 24th Street, said terminus being S 67°41'55" W. a distance of 802.11 feet from the northeast corner of said section 30.

2348.09 Feet = 0.44 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.

PASSED this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1970.
