WHEREAS, there has been filed in the Clerk of the Council's office Initiative No. 2 asking that there be presented to the electors of King County the following proposition: "Abolition of Land Use Regulations;" and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions regarding processing Initiatives, as found in Ordinance No. 159 providing for procedure, the Council Clerk approved the form of the petition on January 28, 1970, and so notified the petitioner; and,


WHEREAS, aforesaid Ordinance provides in part that the petitioner must return the required number of petitions bearing names of qualified electors equal in number to ten per cent (10%) of the amount of persons voting at the last election for County Executive within 60 days from the date of approval; and,

WHEREAS, said petitioner has failed to file the required number of completed petitions at the expiration of 60 days; now, therefore,

BE IT MOVED by the King County Council that Initiative No. 2, asking that land regulations in King County be removed, be declared a nullity.
