THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL, by this Motion, does accept the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, attached hereto which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on April 17, 1970, regarding the Reclassification of certain property petitioned by Steward's Foundation, designated by the Department of Planning No. P 69-219, and the Council does concur with the recommendations contained therein.

The Council recognizes that the dedication of the Right of Way for the proposed extension of South 128th Street from Military Road to South 130th is necessary to accomplish a realignment of this street. The Council also recognizes that as the present Right of Way for the street was dedicated by the applicant, it should be returned to him by vacation at the time of the new dedication.
