

MOTION NO. 0252

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Labor, through its Manpower Development Program, desires to assist local governments in developing and training disadvantaged individuals for public service careers, and

WHEREAS, it is the public policy of King County to encourage the employment of disadvantaged and minority persons, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that King County participate with the United States Department of Labor in the development and implementation of the Public Service Careers Program, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Labor will financially assist King County in the implementation of the program,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, as follows:

1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as are required by the Department of Labor.

2. That the Public Service Careers Program is in accord with the employment policy of King County and within the objectives of Article 5 - Personnel System - of the Home Rule Charter.

3. That the United States of America and the Department of Labor are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
