THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL, by this Motion, does accept the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, attached hereto, which was filed with the Clerk of the Council July 29, 1970, regarding the preliminary approval of a Planned Unit Development petitioned by BELLEVUE COUNTRY CLUB DEVELOPMENT CO., designated by the Department of Planning No. 211-70-P, and the Council does concur with the recommendations contained therein, with the following modifications:

- On page 11 of the Examiner's report, recommendation 1-i shall be modified to read as follows: "A bond in the amount of \$50,000. shall be posted to assure landscaping in compliance with the landscape plan".
- On page 11 of the Examiner's report recommendation 1-f shall be modified to read as follows: "Plans for off-shore moorage facilities shall be approved by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Washington State Department of Ecology and the State Department of Natural Resources".
- 3) On page 12 of the Examiner's report there shall be added to the recommendations an item 1-u, which shall read as follows:

"The applicant shall cooperate in the development of an urban trails system that will incorporate the possibility of connection to a trail around Lake Sammamish in order to provide a public portion that could be used for public access in this trail system adjacent to the existing western boundary of the property".

It is the Council's conclusion that the modification accomplished by item number 1 above is necessary to insure compliance with Comprehensive Plan principle D-28 and the accomplishment of Examiner recommendations 1-c, 1-d, and 1-h. Further modification provided for by item number 2 above acknowledges that Lake Sammamish is a navigable body of water and as such its use is under the control of the State of Washington through its Department of Natural

Resources. The addition of item 3 above, is pursuant to Comprehensive Plan policy E-3.
