

MOTION NO. 0312

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 provides for the making of grants by the U. S. Department of Justice through the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of King County to advance knowledge related to rehabilitation of jail/prison inmates, and

WHEREAS, participation in this program has immediate relevance to Washington State plans to improve the availability and dissemination of educational and training materials for criminal justice personnel, students, and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That an application be made to the Law and Justice Planning Office for a grant for the purpose of preparing a graphic narrative documenting formulas and techniques utilized by Work Release Program staff members of the King County Department of Public Safety, emphasizing five primary Work Release Program features, for distribution to interested parties throughout the United States.

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute and to file such application with the Law and Justice Planning Office, to execute such contracts as are required by said office, and to act as the authorized correspondent.

3. That the said purpose is in accordance with the public safety policy and program of King County.
