THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

SE 290th Street (Kent-Black Diamond Rd. - 160th Ave. SE)
160th Avenue SE (SE 290th St. - SE 287th St.)
SE 287th Street (160th Ave. SE - Westerly 654.56')

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as SE 290th Street, 160th Avenue SE & SE 287th Street be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of SE 290th Street said point being S 33° 01' 58.6" E a distance of 898.78 feet from the north quarter corner of Sec. 2, T. 21 N., R. 5 E., W.M.; Thence in a northeasterly direction a distance of 2217.14 feet to a terminus on the centerline of SE 287th Street, said terminus being N 63° 49' 58.4" E a distance of 734.26 feet from the south quarter corner of Sec. 35, T. 22 N., R. 5 E., W.M.

2217.14 Feet = 0.42 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
