SE 218th Street (132nd Avenue SE to 128th Avenue SE) A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

SE 218th Street

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of 132nd Avenue SE. said point being S 1º 17' 07" W a distance of 175.01 feet from the NE corner of S 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 9, Twp. 22 N., Range 5 E., W.M.; Thence in a westerly direction a distance of 1363.58 feet to a terminus on the west line of said subdivision, said terminus being S 1° 12' 51" W a distance of 125.06 feet from the NW corner of said subdivision.

1363.58 feet = .258 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
