THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

Chautauquah Road Revision (88th Avenue SW - Northwesterly  
1,000 Feet)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King  
County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

Chautauquah Road Revision

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of  
such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of Chautauquah Road  
said point being S 34° 34' 36" E a distance of 392.67 feet from  
the NE corner of the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Sec. 32,  
Twp. 23 N., Range 3 E., W.M.; Thence northwesterly 1,000 feet to  
a terminus on the centerline of said road, said terminus being  
N 36° 10' 55" W a distance of 555.40 feet from the NE corner of  
said subdivision.

1,000 Feet = 0.19 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said road-  
way along the course and description set forth is a public neces-  
sity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works  
to make an examination of said road and report upon same as re-  
quired by law.
