3 WHEREAS, on January 12, 1970, the County Council of King  
4 County, Washington passed Ordinance No. 305, establishing King  
5 County Road Improvement District No. 53 (53rd Avenue S - S 348th  
6 Street to S 350th Street), and

7 WHEREAS, said Ordinance directed the Director of the Depart-  
8 ment of Public Works to proceed with the improvements, and upon  
9 determination of the costs, to prepare and file with the Clerk of  
10 the King County Council an Assessment Roll for that portion of the  
11 entire cost and expense of said improvements to be assessed against  
12 the property included within Road Improvement District No. 53, and

13 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works has  
14 prepared and filed with the Clerk of the King County Council said  
15 assessment roll, now, therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of King County, Wash-  
17 ington, as follows:

18 SECTION 1: The hearing upon the assessment roll for the  
19 improvements in Road Improvement District No. 53 shall be scheduled  
20 for October 19, 1970, at 9:30 A.M.

21 SECTION 2: The King County Council will sit as a Board of  
22 Equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment  
23 roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such  
24 objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will  
25 correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or  
26 any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assess-  
27 ment be made de novo as to such body shall appear just and equit-  
28 able and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

29 SECTION 3: The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby  
30 directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to the owner or  
31 reputed owner of the property whose name appears thereon, by  
32 mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen (15) days before the  
33 date fixed for the hearing to such or reputed owner at the address

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of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer; in addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two (2) times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file same with the Clerk of the Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
